

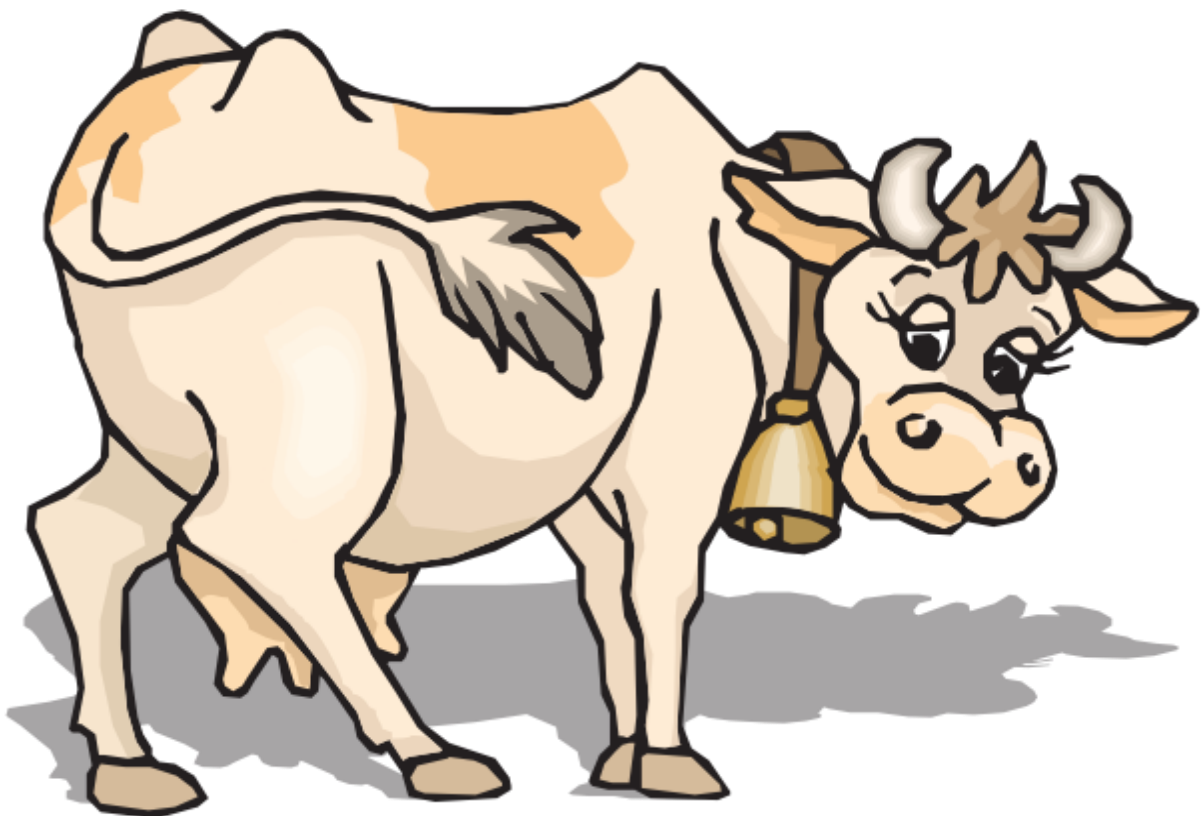

# Parader Competition

This competition is for young people that is designed to encourage interests in dairy cattle and development of handling skills in the show ring.

It is the HANDLER, not the animal that is being judged.

Competitors will be expected to parade an animal in the judging ring and stand it up for presentation for the Judge.

Competitors are encouraged to train their own animal however suitable animals may be borrowed at the show.

Animals of the Parader section don't necessarily need to be a registered or stud animals but must be used for dairying.

We hope that young people not normally involved shows will take to opportunity to participate.

**Class 1:** Junior Parader 7 Years and Under

**Class 2:** Junior Parader 8 to 10 Years

**Class 3:** Junior Parader 11 to 13 Years

**Class 4:** Junior Parader 14 to 17 Years
